Packing List for The Hunt

The following list is a general guide for things you may want to include when you pack for hunt camp. Generally, we suggest gathering everything you want to bring, then going back and putting about half of it back in the closet.

- ___ a weekends worth of clothes (long sleeve and short sleeve t-shirts, jeans, socks, underwear)
 - ___ hunting apparel if you have it (jackets, safety vest, hats and boots)
 - ___ a sweatshirt or two (early morning and evenings can be cool)
 - ___ hunting boots & shoes (sneakers, crocks)
 - ___ pillow and sleeping bag
 - ___ other personal items (toothbrush, soap, shampoo, deodorant, razor, cosmetics, etc.)
 - ___ medications (anything prescribed must have the original pharmacy label, including Dr.'s name and **MUST BE GIVEN TO GENIE IN ADVANCE**)
- **Please pack one suitcase/small bag or backpack****

*****All firearms will be in the care of the Field Staff at all times. Field staff will carry firearms walking to and from the hunting blind and will be in their possession until student is ready to take a shot. *****
